## **INCLEMENT WEATHER**

Closing due to snow, cold, or hazardous driving conditions

- School will be cancelled if heavy snow and/or icy conditions make it extremely hazardous or impossible for school buses to travel their routes and for employee to get to work safely.
- Every effort will be made to make a decision by approximately 6:00 a.m. the morning of a cancellation.
- Notification will be sent directly to families through Synergy email, TRZ phone call, and posted on the school website.
- Notification will be sent to media outlets, website and Facebook
- If school is in session and the weather is forecasted to worsen during the day, decisions will be made as to when to dismiss as early in the day as possible.
- Cancellations include:
- All classes and programs K-8
- Before and After Care Program and extra-curricular activities.
- Field trips and school events
- Community Education Classes
- Building events (open houses, conferences, etc.)
