Program Services Committee (Smitley/Carlson)

- Director Report: Data presentation by Angela Dunn using beginning of the year data from Fastbridge, Fountas & Pinnell reading (comprehension & level), CBM reading (fluency & accuracy), BAR (Becoming a Reader).
 - Goals for this school year: 70% K-2 score Low risk or exceeds on Fastbridge reading, 70% Meets or Exceeds in MCA reading in 3rd grade, 75% 3-8th score Meets or exceeds in MCA reading, reduce % of students scoring partially meets and increase students scoring meets or exceeds on MCA reading.
 - Research suggesting students in grades K-2 are showing a loss of 2 to 4 months due to Covid. 3rd and up have better retention.

- Full data graphs were provided to the board and reviewed. The following is a summary.
- Reading Average K-2: 59% low risk, 27% some risk, 5% high risk. 3rd-8th: 78% low risk, 22% some and high risk.
- Math K-1 has 71%, 21% and 8%. 2-4 has 74%, 26% and 5-8 has 77%, 23%.
 Students fairing better in math than reading.
- Comparing data between 2019 and 2020, most grade levels decreased in reading (4th, 6th, 7th increased or stayed same). Math was similar.
- Comparing data with/in classes (example last year's K to this year's 1st, same students, minus those that have moved or are new) Reading: Lower grades show lower scores than previous year, 3rd and up are either even or a little bit higher. Math: Most grades scored lower than previous year with 1 & 2 showing greater discrepancy, 7th grade was higher.
- Aspen is prepared to meet these goals. Have math interventionists, 2 EL teachers, 4 reading corps teachers (1 specifically for K), 1 math corps for 4th-8th, SpEd department, new curriculum for K-1, monthly team data meetings. Will be comparing distance learners with hybrid learners internally.

 Committee Report: The committee met October 7th to review 3 policies up for annual review. MSBA updated their model policy 522. It was much different and longer than their previous policy. The committee "Aspenized" it, changing superintendent to director, adding the Title IX coordinator, etc. In 524, only a few small changes were made. One being that there will not be an actual Technology Use Agreement. It will be included with the signing of the Parent/Student Handbook on the Google form. There were no changes made to policy 616. A comment was made that policy 413 has similar language and will most likely need to be updated also.

Finance & Facility Committee (Allison/Faulise/Schutrop/Price)

- Director Report: Wait list for next year has about 65 kids on it already. Encouraging those who are able to make a change this year rather than wait until next year, if there are openings.
- Committee Report: Committee met before the board meeting, current budget was reviewed with revised ADM at 630, looked at current enrollment numbers, no issues with facilities and update on PPP loan spending and forgiveness application. Presentation of Financials by David Kloskin - revised budget is based on 630 ADM, conservative since enrollment at this time looks to be around 654. Budget includes PPP loan, CRF and CARES money, showing a (\$600,0000 surplus). Aspen is 25% of the way through the fiscal year, DSCR 1.31, days cash on hand 104. \$144,000 CRF money has been spent, had to be spent by Dec 31. CARES money can be spent through 2022. PPP loan proceeds about \$613,000, should be in good standing even if we have to pay back 10%. Sterling is currently accepting loans. David will look into submitting paperwork in December. Sterling has 90 days then to let us know how much will be forgiven. Kudos to Dave, Connie and Mike for managing the Covid funds and budget! No questions on the check register.
