#### Program Services Committee (Smitley/Carlson)

- Administration Report: Update on Special Education by Kelly Dietrich
  - Schools get SpEd funding from 3 places, state, federal and 3<sup>rd</sup> party billing. Increase in number of students from last year, up to 79.
  - Looking at maintenance of effort for this year, Aspen is behind in spending and will need to spend more to catch up. Will spend on math curriculum, transportation, etc. MN requested waiver to allow schools not to have to spend up to their MOE due to lowered costs of the pandemic, waiver was denied.
  - Next year, can add school psychologist, might be decrease in transportation due to the new reduction in IDEA payments for transporting students outside of the district, would impact 4 families next year.
  - Coding errors may have occurred in FY20 for transportation. Kelly is still looking into the situation.
  - Lots of positive feedback from staff and parents about current school year
  - Caseloads are on the high side, Kelly recommends adding another teacher next year, a .25FTE due process person and increase in social work time.
  - SpEd teachers are hard to find, Kelly recommends a hiring bonus, comparable salary to a district or separate pay scale.
  - Lots of PD has happened this year for paras and staff
  - According to MACS and MSBA, doesn't look like a reduction in SpEd funding right now.
  - Other legislation possible coming up: 16 hours of training per year for paras, schools have a seizure action plan, Covid-19 recovery plan for SpEd students, and a bill to prohibit the dismissal of K-3 students.

# Finance & Facility Committee (Allison/Faulise/Schutrop)

Administration Report: By Word of Mouth, Ltd. Contract in year 2 of 2. There are 3 options for busing next year: 1. Keep the same as we are doing now through PLS district 2. Use PLSBA directly with current bell schedule and similar calendar with 6 in-district and 2 out of district buses to get some of the cost from the state back. 3. Use PLSBA with option of having a different bell schedule and calendar. There would be an increase of \$25-\$50,000 for option 2. Option 3 wouldn't be needed since we aren't changing our schedule. Mr. Sandberg communicated with the district and they said they will make our 12:30 early releases work as well as the 2 hour releases. The board decided to stay with our current bus contract and does not need to approve a new one.

Did not need to approve new bus contract.

- Motion: Approve the busing contract.
- Committee Report: The committee met prior to the meeting tonight. Looking at a surplus of \$600,000. Still have ESSR funds available to spend over the next 2 years. Enrollment is currently 643, budgeted for 630. Enrollment is high for next year around 789, expected to decrease as usual between 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> grades. No update on facility. Admin and finance committee will start looking at FY22 in March, technology needs with Wade. Committee will meet to review special education maintenance of effort spending separately. No review of financials. No questions on the check register.
