General Supplies KEPT by each Student

- Backpack without wheels labeled with student name
- Rubber eraser
- Scissors

- Instrument- determined by you and Mr. Fairweather before you start class. Please email Mr. Fairweather and have your instrument rented or purchased before school starts
 - Lesson Book- Students will purchase Tradition of Excellence Book 1 for (your instrument).
 - Pencils- kept in your instrument case where possible
 - *Optional- A wire music stand- gets your music at the correct height
 - Instrument accessories- some are included when you rent the instrument:
 - Woodwinds- Flutes- soft cloth for cleaning the inside of the flute; an old dish drying towel
 - Clarinets and Saxophones- Extra reeds, swab on a string with a weight for cleaning the inside of your instrument, cork grease, Neck strap for saxophone- padded ones cost a little more but hold the weight of the instrument more comfortably
 - Trumpets, Baritones, Tubas- Valve oil; Blue Juice is recommended, slide grease
 - French Horn; Rotary valve oil, slide grease
 - Trombone; Slide cream or grease, I use something called Slide O Mix along with a very small spray bottle for water for your slide
 - Percussion; besides renting or purchasing a beginning percussion kit, students should have a stick bag with 2 pair of sticks and at least one pair of bell mallets that travel to and from school

Symphonic Band (if applicable)

- *** One year of experience required on your band instrument, your band instrument.
- Lessons Book- Tradition of Excellence Book 2 for your instrument
- *Optional- Wire music stand- gets your music at the correct height
- Same Instrument Accessories as Concert Band for your instrument.
