#### RESPECT SELF

- Stay out of the bus danger zone.
- When riding the bus, remain seated at all times.

#### RESPECT OTHERS

- Keep hands, feet and belongings to yourself.
- Use quiet voices and be courteous.
- Follow the driver's instructions.

#### RESPECT PROPERTY

- Bring only school-approved items on the bus.
- Be respectful of bus space and equipment.

#### RESPECT SELF


## Know the Bus Rules!



 The "danger zone" is all the space within 10 feet around the bus.



 The most dangerous areas are close to the tires and right in front of the bus.




REMEMBER! The driver can not see you in the "danger zone!"

- Always cross in front of the bus.
   Wait for the driver to signal.
- Never enter the "danger zone" to pick up papers, mittens, balls, etc.

## Be Safe: Waiting for the Bus

Dress for the weather

 Be on time – arrive no more than 10 minutes before the bus arrives



## Be Safe: Waiting for the Bus

- Use respectful behaviors:
  - Keep hands/feet to self
  - Stay away from curb and off the road
  - Use respectful language
  - Stay at bus stop
- Wait for the bus to STOP, then get on.







Do you know how to be safe riding the bus?

**Turn and Talk!** 

- When the door opens, enter the bus one at a time using the handrail.
  - Younger students in front board first.



#### RESPECT SELF:

- Go directly to your assigned seat and sit down.
- Backs to the back, seats to the seat, feet on the floor. (Sitting safe.)
- Keep your body inside the bus.




#### RESPECT OTHERS:

- Use a quiet voice
- Keep hands and feet to self.
- Keep aisle clear
- Do not throw anything
- Your bus driver is in charge



#### RESPECT PROPERTY:

- Take care of the bus.
- No eating or drinking on bus. (unless driver approved)
- Animals, weapons,
   and illegal drugs are
   not allowed.
- Do not tamper with bus safety equipment.



REMEMBER:
Riding the bus
is a privilege,
not a right.

#### RESPECT SELF:

- Stay in your seat until the bus stops.
- Remember to take everything with you.
- Exit from front to back.



#### RESPECT OTHERS:

- Don't push or crowd.
- Use the handrail.
- Let younger students off first



#### RESPECT SELF:

- Quickly exit the "danger zone."
- Look both ways and watch for the driver to signal before crossing in front of the bus.



#### • RESPECT SELF:

- When arriving at school, go directly to your assigned area.
- After school, go directly home or to your designated after-school site.



- There are three different evacuation plans:
  - Using only the front service door
  - Using only the rear (or side)
     emergency door
  - Using both the service door & the emergency door



#### While Evacuating

- Be quiet and wait for instruction
- Be alert, move quickly and leave personal belongings on the bus
- Keep your feet out of the aisle, go out seat by seat, alternating sides.



- Duck your head when going out the emergency door.







#### While Evacuating

- After you are out of the door, move away from the bus as this clears the way for others to follow.
- Go a distance of at least 100 feet from the bus and remain there in a group until given further instructions by the driver.



- The school bus has rules and consequences just like a classroom.
- If the rules are not followed, these steps will be taken...



#### Level I Offenses

- Standing on the bus
- Yelling, excessive noise, mischief
- Eating, drinking, littering on the bus
- "Play fighting," horseplay
- Pushing, shoving

#### **Offenses**

- Teasing, profanity
- Smoking, Vape Pens
- Forms of insubordination
- Other offenses as reported by the bus driver

#### PROGRESSIVE DISCIPLINE

1<sup>st</sup> Notice- Warning

2<sup>nd</sup> Notice – Assigned Seat

3<sup>rd</sup> Notice - 3 day Suspension from bus

4<sup>th</sup> Notice – 5 day Suspension from bus

5<sup>th</sup> Notice - 10 day suspension from bus

6<sup>th</sup> Offense – School Year Suspension

<sup>\*</sup>Administration reserves the right to use discretion in issuing consequences.



#### Level 2 Offenses

- Hanging out of the windows
- Throwing of ANY object
- Fighting, physical aggression, assault
- Harassment, threats, bullying behavior
- Serious insubordination (where the student does NOT comply)
- Possession, use/distribution of chemicals or tobacco

#### Level 2 Offenses

- Vandalism to the bus
- Possession or use of any weapons
- Lighting of matches or other flame, fire items
- Unauthorized entrance/exit through emergency door
- Other illegal acts or offenses as reported by the driver

#### Level 2 Consequences

1<sup>st</sup> Offense - 1-3 day suspension

2<sup>nd</sup> Offense - 3-5 day suspension

3<sup>rd</sup> Offense - 5-10 day suspension

4<sup>th</sup> Offense - 10 day suspension

5<sup>th</sup> Offense - School year suspension
