## Description:

The Penguin Corps, now entering its fourth year, is an award-winning club whose purpose is to educate students in the foundations of Linux and open source software and have fun doing it. Kids will learn the values of Free and Open Source Software, computer hardware, and software installation & configuration. Students will then apply that knowledge by refurbishing used computers for people in need. Kids will also learn the basics of an "in demand" field of computing that most major companies are looking to hire in. The Penguin Corps is the second middle school Linux club in Minnesota, and one of only a handful in North America. The club has had over 100 members, provided over 400 computers for students to use, presented at 10 technology and educational conferences, won the 2021 MESPA STEM Innovation Award, and started a YouTube channel that has gotten thousands of views. Because so many of our activities are in the public eye, a signed media release form is required for all members (Mr. Keroff will provide this). Students will be expected to have a willingness to learn, experiment, to try something new, and to be team players. Regular attendance, good behavior, and a good attitude are required.
