HOW E-LEARNING DAYS WORK

- E-Learning Days are for students in grades 6-8 only.
- E-Learning Days will be communicated through email, phone, website, social media, and local TV stations.
- Curriculum-aligned activities will be posted for students to access on Google Classroom through either Aspen assigned devices or scholar/families' personal devices.
- E-Learning days will proceed in an asynchronous manner, meaning scholars will not attend "live" digital class sessions.
- All scholars will have up to 3 days to turn in assignments (provisions will be made for scholars with IEPs or 504 plans).
- Attendance will be taken based on a submitted assignment in the scholar's Advisory class.
- Parent/Guardian must contact the school to excuse an absence on an E-Learning day.
- Staff will provide guidance and feedback on class work through email and/or Google Classroom.

SCHOLAR AND TEACHER EXPECTATIONS

- Teachers will post an asynchronous assignment to their Google Classroom page by 9:00am.
- Scholars will work at their own pace on assignments
- Scholars will complete assignments from each of the classes they would have normally attended that day (including specialists).
- Teachers will be available for questions from parents/guardians and scholars from 9:00-11:00am and 1:00-3:00pm
