I Love To Read Month!

During the month of February, Aspen scholars and staff will receive: the book "The Borrowers", by Mary Norton. Each Aspen family will receive one copy of the book and a bookmark with the reading schedule on January 31st, 2024.


In "The Borrowers," a tiny family resides beneath the kitchen of a regular-sized house where "human beans" live. This family borrows items from the humans to craft a comfortable life in their miniature home. For instance, they might use borrowed postage stamps as paintings. However, the Borrowers must exercise caution, as being discovered by a human means they may never be seen again.

Throughout the month, there will be weekly trivia and discussions about the book in your scholar's homeroom. If your scholar prefers, "The Borrowers" is also available for free through the Libby App in audiobook format.

Aspen scholars will collectively participate in tracking their reading minutes at home. For every 20 minutes a scholar reads, parents are to sign a paper button. These buttons will help staff monitor reading minutes throughout February. Upon achieving reading goals, school-wide prizes will be awarded to our scholars!

Reminder of Winter Screening Assessments

Hello Families!

Believe it or not it is January, even though there is no snow on the ground!

This means it's time to check in on all the progress our scholars have made so far this year. Starting January 8th, the scholars will complete the winter FastBridge Learning® screening assessments. We use these assessments in the fall, winter and spring to provide information to teachers about which scholars need their instruction differentiated.

Some of the assessments are administered in the classroom on Chromebooks and some are administered one on one with the teacher or other trained staff.

Here's the list of assessments: Grades K: earlyReading and earlyMath Grade 1: earlyReading and earlyMath Grades 2-5: aReading, CBM-Reading, AUTOreading, aMath, CBM Math Automaticity, and the Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Screener (4th and 5th grades only) Grades 6-8: aReading, AUTOreading, aMath, CBMmath Automaticity, and the Social, Academic, and Emotional Behavior Screener

Remind your scholars to do their best and have a positive attitude! This information helps us document all their growth for the first half of the year! Try to make sure your scholar gets a good night's sleep and encourage your scholar to eat a healthy breakfast.

We are excited to share with you the news on your scholar's progress on these screening assessments as well as their progress towards their academic goals in February during winter conferences!
